Our annual Workplace Safety Funds grant program is designed to reward LHA Trust Funds members devoted to employee safety.

This year's program is expanding to allow you to use your creativity to develop innovative opportunities to improve safety in your workplace. Focus your efforts on areas of the workplace that pose hazards to employee safety and wellness in your unique organization.

Do I qualify for Workplace Safety Funds?

Members of the LHA Workers' Compensation Fund who have premiums in excess of \$10,000 are eligible to participate.

What is the goal of the Workplace Safety Funds grant program?

Our goal for the Workplace Safety Funds Program is to support members in reducing employee injuries and illnesses making the workplace safer.

What type of project will qualify?

Your project should be specific to the needs of your organization. Your ideas can focus on any category that impacts workplace safety for example but not limited to: Safe Patient Handling & Mobility; Safe Materials Lifting; Workplace Violence Prevention; Slip, Trip, and Fall Prevention; or Sharp Injury & Needlestick Prevention, etc. Contact Stacie Jenkins, Vice President of Patient Safety and Risk, at StacieJenkins@LHATrustFunds.com for project approval.

Most ideas to reduce risk to employee safety will be considered. You can choose to work on one area or multiple areas that impact workplace safety. Your project must be approved in advance to be eligible for funding.
